Sav. Fire discontinued using VHF and has been switched to 800MHZ effect 1-26-11. Upgrade for Tiburon and Positron: Major Barnwell reports 4 to 6 month schedule both upgrades to be at same time. Additional funding for positron has been approved by City Council and Communications is moving forward.

Fire Chiefs would like a look see of the new Tiburon. Major Barnwell to follow-up.

911 Backup: Command and Control Center at the Civic Center. Construction RFP currently out for bid. Responses due Feb 1, 2011. Bids to be opened on Feb. 8, 2011 and will then be awarded after approval by from City Council. Construction should begin in March 2011 with substantial completion in May. Total project completion July 2011. Total project includes Command Operations Area and the 911 Backup Center.
