

## **Emergency Evacuation Kit for Functional and Medical Needs Patients**

In the event of an evacuation, there are several items that you will need to bring with you before being taken to an inland shelter including:

- <u>Medications</u>: Supplies of prescription and non-prescription drugs for one month.
- <u>Important documentation</u> including picture I.D., insurance cards and policies, copy of living will/durable Power of Attorney for healthcare, birth certificates, military papers, divorce papers, etc.
- <u>Personal Items</u>: Eyeglasses, contact lenses and solution, pillow, and comfort items such as books and games.
- <u>Clothing</u>: Changes for at least one week, including comfortable shoes.
- <u>Sanitary Supplies</u>: One week's supply of toilet paper, towelettes, feminine supplies, and other personal hygiene items including diapers.
- <u>Contact Information</u>: Current information, numbers, and names of those who should be contacted should you become ill or injured, including your doctors.
- Special Equipment: Extra wheelchair batteries, oxygen, and other necessary medical supplies.
- <u>List</u>: Style and serial numbers of medical devices such as pacemakers.
