E911 RECOMMENDATION REVIEW COMMITTEE
APPROVALS



October 17, 2018

- a. The Committee strongly recommends implementation of the International Academy of Emergency Dispatch's (IAED), Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) program, to include response determinates being transmitted to the Ambulance Service at the time of call intake.
- b. The Committee strongly recommends implementation of the IAED, EMD program, to include pre-arrival instructions to callers.
- c. The Committee strongly recommends implementation of the IAED, EMD program to include Pro-QA
- d. The Committee strongly recommends implementation of the IAED, EMD program, to include "AQUA"

December 11, 2018 Approvals

- a. The subcommittee was approved and the EAB will move forward with EAB conditions that allows the Fire and Police Department to review their **priority** dispatch programs.
- b. An adoption to address the standards for fire hydrants across the County were approved with conditions that more information needs to be provided.
- c. An adoption of a standard for street naming and develop a standard for layering

January 16, 2019 Approvals

- a. Meetings will now be bi-monthly starting after the February meeting
- b. Create a E911 GIS Coordinator position to provide all geospatial database management, design, implementation and analysis required for public safety and E911 operations in Chatham County
- c. Create an additional primary dispatch channel for west side municipal police departments and split dispatching in Chatham County
- d. Adopt a Fire Priority Dispatch System (FPDS) program along with the Quality Assurance and training programs offered.
