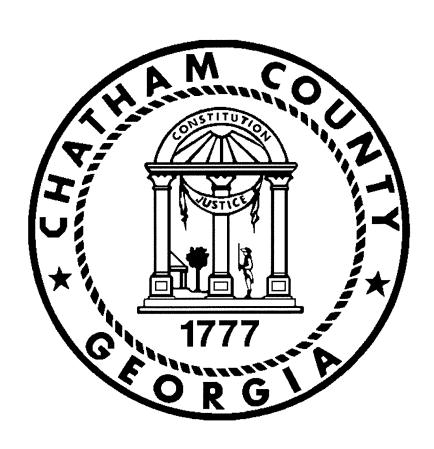
COMMENT RELATIVE TO STATISTICAL SECTION

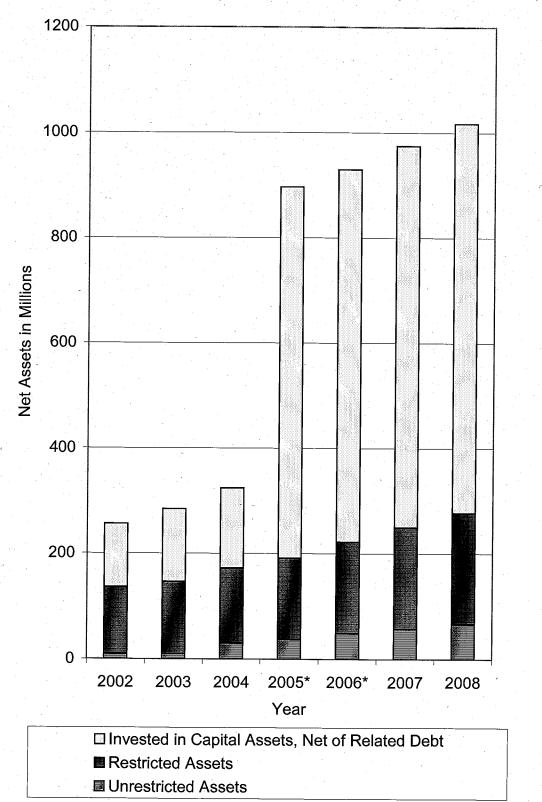

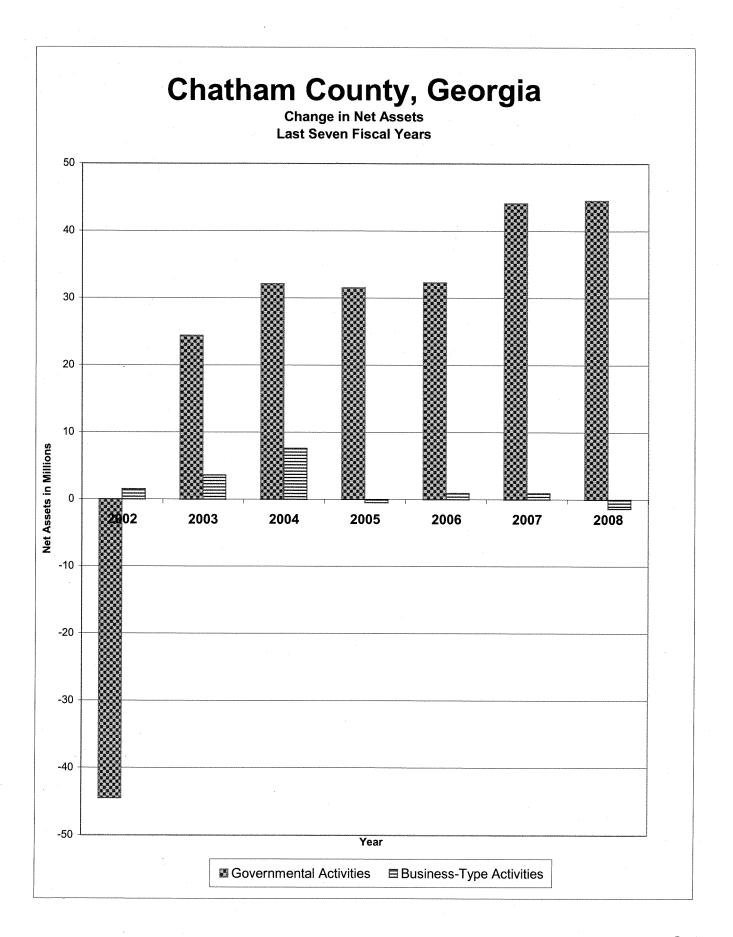
Total Government Net Assets Last Seven Fiscal Years

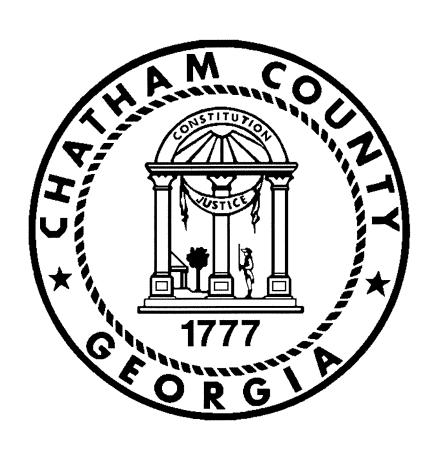

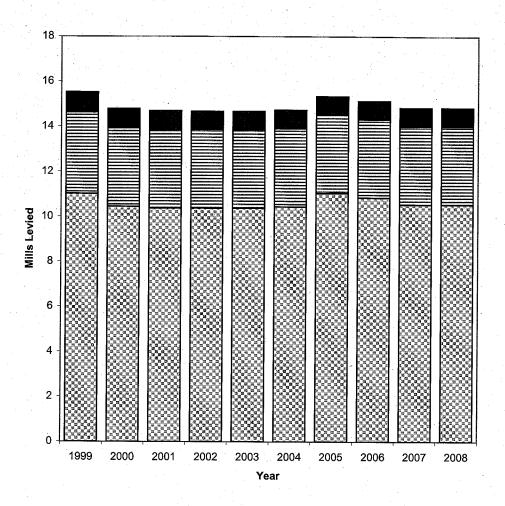
