Statewide Tornado Drill

Chatham County, GA (February 5, 2019) - The Chatham Emergency Management Agency (CEMA) will sound the Outdoor Emergency Warning Siren System Wednesday at 9:00AM to signal the beginning of the statewide tornado drill. The sirens will coincide with the statewide drill; CEMA will not sound the sirens again at noon.

The purpose of the statewide drill is to test people's ability to react quickly during tornadoes or severe weather. Residents should treat the drill as if it were an actual emergency and act as they would if required to take life saving measures.

WHEN: February 6, 2019 9AM

WHO: All Chatham County residents including schools, daycares, nursing homes, businesses, government agencies and other organizations
