County Invites Input on the Future of Parks and Recreation

Residents are encouraged to participate in the master plan survey

Chatham County, GA – Public Meeting for Chatham County Parks and Recreation Master Plan on Monday, May 7, 2018.

Chatham County is developing a Parks and Recreation Master Plan, and wants to hear from all community residents, business owners, sports groups, and any other interested parties. For the next phase of the project, GreenPlay, the nationally-known parks and recreation management consulting firm hired by the County to complete the plan, will be hosting a public Findings presentation. During the presentation they will review the information gathered from the community focus groups, stakeholder meetings, the community surveys, and information from the inventory of parks and facilities as well as an analysis of the county's current level of service.

The Public Meeting will be held on Monday, May 7, 2018, at 6:30 pm until 8:30 pm at the Public Works and Park Services building on 7226 Varnedoe Drive Savannah, Georgia 31406. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend.
