Chatham County Police Identify Person of Interest in Homicide Case

Chatham County, GA (June 11, 2019) – Chatham County Police have identified a person of interest in connection with a fatal shooting that happened last night.

Police are looking for 23-year-old Arkeem Brown, who they want to question about the shooting that left one man dead and another injured. Anyone with information about Brown's whereabouts is asked to call Chatham County Police at 912-652-6920 or Crime Stoppers at 912-234-2020. Tipsters are anonymous and may qualify for a cash reward.

Police were called to the 2500 block of Fort Argyle road on a report of a shooting just after 10:30 p.m. on Monday, June 10, 2019. When they arrived, they found one man dead from an apparent gunshot wound lying behind the Country Convenience Store.

A man who was with the victim says the two were confronted by two other men, and after a brief altercation, the two suspects began firing at the victim and the witness. The witness was not injured.

Approximately four hours after the initial call, Chatham County Police detectives located a second gunshot victim inside a residence. He was transported to the hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Detectives are not releasing the names of the victims at this time.

Police do not believe the shooting incident was random.

Last night, K-9 units from the Chatham County Sheriff's Office and Effingham County Sheriff's Office, and Georgia State Patrol were called out to assist in the search for the suspects.

There is no further information to release at this time. As more information becomes available, it will be released to the public and the media through press releases and the Chatham County Police Department's Facebook page.
