Chatham County Police Collecting Hurricane Relief Donations for First Responders in Florida

Chatham County, GA (October 25, 2018) – The Chatham County Police Department is accepting hurricane relief donations to go to first responders in hurricane-ravaged parts of Florida.

Next week, the department will take a truckload of supplies to areas impacted by Hurricane Michael. The non-perishable food and toiletries will be given to police and fire departments to help support their employees who worked through the storm and are still working, even though they have their own families and homes to take care of.

The public can donate to this cause by dropping off non-perishable food and toiletries to any of the three Chatham County Police precincts weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. The department is accepting donations through Tuesday, October 30.
