Only prescription pills and patches can be turned in at this time. No liquids or sharps.

Background:

According to a 2017 national survey, **6 million Americans misused controlled prescription drugs**. The study shows that a majority of abused prescription drugs were obtained from family and friends, often from the home medicine cabinet. The national take-back day is a safe, convenient, and responsible way to dispose of unused or expired prescription drugs and provides an opportunity for Americans to help prevent drug addiction and overdose deaths.

The U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) hosts no-questions asked National Prescription Drug Take-Back events twice per year where temporary collection sites are set up in cities throughout the nation for safe disposal of prescription drugs, including opioids. The DEA's "Take-Back" initiative is one of several strategies to reduce prescription drug abuse and diversion in the nation. Opioid abuse is at epidemic levels in the U.S., and remains a top public health concern.
