Joint Investigation Leads to Large Drug Seizure

SAVANNAH, Georgia (May 7, 2019): One person is in custody following a large seizure of methamphetamine.

Early yesterday, the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) and the Savannah Police Department were conducting a joint operation. During the operation, contact was made with a suspicious vehicle in the 200 block of Hampstead Avenue. Officers made contact with the driver, 45-year-old Brian Stewart of Savannah. A search of the vehicle resulted in seizure of marijuana, cocaine, and a trafficking amount of liquid methamphetamine. A firearm and more than \$4,000 was also seized.

CNT arrested Stewart and charged him with multiple felony charges to include Trafficking Methamphetamine and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. Stewart was also wanted by the Chatham County Sheriff's Office for Contempt of Court at the time of his arrest. He is being held in the Chatham County Detention Center.
