Search Warrant Leads to Seizure of Drugs and a Firearm

SAVANNAH, Georgia (May 8, 2019): A convicted felon is in custody following a search warrant at his residence and the seizure of drugs and a stolen firearm.

Yesterday, the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 900 block of East Waldburg Street in Savannah. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of marijuana and a large amount of powder and crack cocaine in addition to items commonly associated with the distribution of controlled substances. Also seized was a stolen firearm and nearly \$11,000 in U.S. currency.

CNT arrested the target of the investigation, 67-year-old, Marion Jameison also known as "Hook" without incident. Jameison was charged with multiple felony charges to include Trafficking Cocaine and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. Jameison is being held at the Chatham County Detention Center.

Said CNT Director Everett Ragan, "This residence had a lot of foot and vehicle traffic. Persons would come throughout the day and night to purchase drugs. This of course put the neighbors and community at risk. I am thankful for my team's quick response to get this dealer and his poison off the street."
