### **CNT Arrests Same Person Twice in One Month**

SAVANNAH, Georgia (May 17, 2019): A person arrested by the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) earlier this month has again been arrested on similar charges.

CNT arrested 39-year-old Brandie Milton also known as Brandie Campbell of Savannah. Milton was arrested at a Savannah pharmacy without incident. Milton was charged with Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud and Possession of a Controlled Substance (Ambien). Milton is being held at the Chatham County Detention Center.

Earlier yesterday, CNT was made aware of a fraudulent prescription called into a pharmacy. Agents quickly identified the would-be recipient as Milton. Unbeknownst to Milton, undercover CNT agents were standing behind her at the pharmacy as she purchased the controlled substances and took possession of them. Agents made contact with Milton and placed her under arrest. Additional evidence seized suggested Milton recently obtained fraudulent prescriptions under an alias.

Milton was arrested by CNT on May 2, 2019, for Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud and Criminal Attempt to Obtain a Controlled Substance. During that investigation, it was determined that between April 16 and April 26, Milton was posing as a medical assistant with her doctor's office for the purpose of illegally obtaining a prescription sleeping medication. Milton was out on bond for that incident. In another CNT case in April of 2016, Milton was arrested by CNT for similar acts and charged with Attempt or Conspiracy to Violate the Georgia Controlled Substances Act.

This is an ongoing investigation and additional charges are expected.
