Joint Operation Leads to the Seizure of Drugs and Weapons

SAVANNAH, Georgia (June 26, 2019): One person is in custody following the seizure of various narcotics and weapons.

Early this morning, the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) and the Georgia State Board of Pardons and Parole conducted a search of a residence located in the 200 block of Croatan Street in Savannah. The search resulted in the seizure of prescription medication, marijuana, and items commonly associated with the distribution of controlled substances. Also seized were two firearms and more than \$5500 in U.S. currency.

Agents arrested 25-year-old Kwame Hampton of Savannah. Hampton was charged with Probation Violation and is being held at the Chatham County Detention Center.

The joint operation occurred early this morning after it was determined Hampton was wanted for Probation Violation.

This is an on-going investigation and additional charges are forthcoming.
