CNT Search Warrant Results in Seizure of Crack Cocaine and Firearms

SAVANNAH, Georgia (August 19, 2019): A convicted felon is in custody following the seizure of drugs and firearms.

On Friday, August 16, 2019, the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 700 block of East Waldburg Street in Savannah without incident. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of crack cocaine, marijuana, and two firearms; one which returned stolen. CNT arrested 35-year-old Hassan Reynolds of Savannah. Reynolds was charged with Possession of Cocaine and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. Reynolds is being held in the Chatham County Detention Center.

CNT began its investigation into the residence on East Waldburg Street after identifying it as a location where crack cocaine was being sold from. Over the course of the investigation, undercover CNT agents made purchases of crack cocaine from Reynolds and others.

This is an ongoing investigation and additional arrests and charges are possible.
