### **CNT Operations Lead to Crystal Methamphetamine Seizures**

CHATHAM COUNTY, Georgia (October 3, 2019): Two people are in custody following independent operations where crystal methamphetamine was seized.

Early yesterday evening, the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) arrested 26-year-old Victoria Ramey of Savannah. Agents arrested Ramey at a hotel on Gateway Boulevard where she was staying. Ramey was arrested after being found in possession of crystal methamphetamine and items consistent with the use and distribution of controlled substances. CNT's investigation into Ramey began in August following information suggesting she sold methamphetamine. Undercover CNT agents made several purchases from her at various hotels throughout the investigation. Ramey was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute (Methamphetamine). Additional charges are expected.

In an unrelated investigation, CNT arrested 33-year-old Dodge Roberson yesterday evening with the assistance of the Pooler Police Department. A search of Roberson and his vehicle resulted in the seizure of crystal methamphetamine, heroin, prescription medication and items consistent with the distribution of controlled substances. Roberson's vehicle and more than \$1,400 was also seized. Roberson was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance (Methamphetamine) with Intent to Distribute. Roberson was also found to be wanted for Probation Violation at the time of his arrest. Additional charges are expected.

Both Ramey and Roberson are being held in the Chatham County Detention Center.
