CNT Conducts Early Morning Search Warrant

SAVANNAH, GEORGIA (October 25, 2019): One person is in custody following an early morning search warrant executed by the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT).

Early this morning, CNT executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 1300 block of East 32nd Street. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of a sizable amount of methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA) also known as ecstasy, prescription medications, marijuana, and items commonly associated with the distribution of controlled substances. A firearm was also seized. CNT arrested 39-year-old Michael Smalls of Savannah. Smalls was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance (a felony) and is being held in the Chatham County Detention Center. Additional charges are expected.

CNT's investigation into Smalls began earlier this month after receiving information he was selling controlled substances from his residence. Over the course of the investigation, undercover CNT agents made several drug purchases from Smalls' residence.
