Search Warrant Results in Arrests and Seizure of Drugs and a Stolen Firearm

SAVANNAH, Georgia (December 4, 2018): A search warrant at a Savannah residence results in the seizure of heroin, crack cocaine, and a firearm, and the arrest of two people.

Early yesterday evening, the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 900 block of East Park Avenue without incident. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of a sizable amount of heroin, crack cocaine, and items commonly associated with the distribution of controlled substances. A stolen firearm was also seized. CNT arrested the homeowner, 57-year-old Michael "Mikey" Young, and 60-year-old Stanley Jackson, both of Savannah. Both Young and Jackson were charged with felony drug charges. Young was also charged with Possession of a Firearm during the Commission of a Felony. Young and Jackson remain in the Chatham County Detention Center.

CNT's investigation began in November after identifying Young as a suspected heroin dealer and suspecting Young was selling heroin from his residence. During the course of the investigation, undercover CNT agents made multiple purchases of heroin from Young and obtained a search warrant for his residence.

The investigation is ongoing and additional charges and arrests are expected.
