CNT Investigation Leads to Large Seizure of MDMA

SAVANNAH, Georgia (December 9, 2019): One person is in custody following the seizure of firearms and approximately four pounds of Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA or Ecstasy).

During the late evening hours of December 5, 2019, members of the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) conducted a search of a hotel room on Savannah's Southside resulting in the seizure of approximately four pounds of MDMA and marijuana. Also seized were two pistols and more than \$650. CNT arrested 39-year-old Willie Moore III of Savannah. Moore III is facing multiple charges to include Trafficking MDMA and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. Moore III is being held in the Chatham County Detention Center.

CNT's investigation into Moore III began following information he was selling large quantities of MDMA throughout the Savannah-Chatham area. During CNT's investigation, agents determined Moore III was currently on probation through Tattnall County and identified he was staying at the hotel in Savannah.
