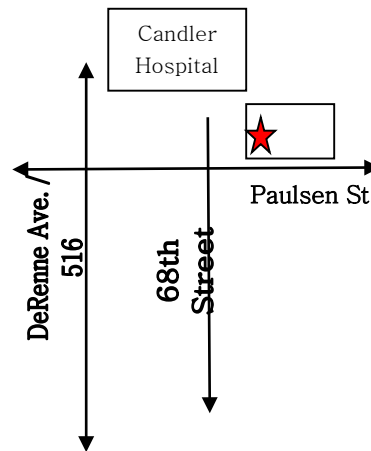

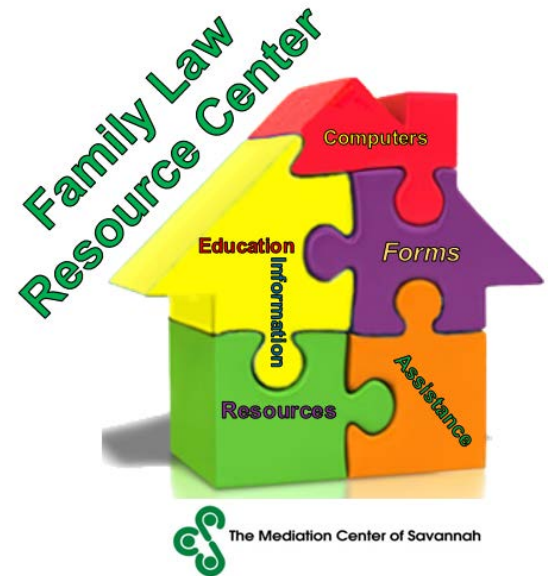

What To Bring

- **Proof or Documents** of income showing how much and where you get money \$\$\$ you live on, for example: Paystubs, Tax Returns, W2s, 1099, Receipts, Disability, Unemployment, Public benefits, child support, alimony, gifts, rent paid to you, tips, cash payments
- **Copies of any papers you have already filed and prior orders that may affect your case**
- **The Other Party** if you can work together and you want to file an UNCONTESTED case
