Chatham County is changing the way jurors are brought in for jury service. Fewer people are being called and check-in has been changed to permit social distancing.

The judges are very aware that masks and social distancing are some of the best ways to keep us safe. Wearing a mask in the courthouse is mandatory and we are following distancing guidelines in jury assembly areas, courtrooms and deliberation rooms.

Jury assembly areas, courtrooms and deliberation rooms are being thoroughly cleaned throughout each day.
