ORDER FOR DETENTION

WHEREAS the above-styled case came on for hearing pursuant to OCGA § 15-11-506 to determine whether preadjudication custody of the above-named alleged delinquent juvenile is required; and,

WHEREAS a detention assessment was administered to determine whether such juvenile should be detained, taking into account the provisions of OCGA § 15-11-505(b); and

WHEREAS at the commencement of the detention hearing, the juvenile was advised as required by OCGA § 15-11-506(f);

AND, it appearing that there is probable cause to believe that such juvenile committed the act of which he or she is accused, and that there is clear and convincing evidence such child's freedom should be restrained, that no less restrictive alternatives will suffice,

It is hereby ordered that said child is to be detained pursuant to OCGA § 15-11-503 for the following reason(s):

- () Such child's detention or care is required to reduce the likelihood that he or she may inflict serious bodily harm on others during the interim period;
- () Such child has a demonstrated pattern of theft or destruction of property such that detention is required to protect the property of others;
- () Such child's detention is necessary to secure his or her presence in court to protect the jurisdiction and processes of the court;
- () An order for the child's detention has been made by the court.

It is further ordered that the place of detention shall be:
