

CHATHAM COUNTY DUI COURT ACLP INFORMATION

You are receiving an Accountability Court Limited Permit (ACLP). DDS is being provided with _____ as your contact number. If you do not answer their call, they will leave a message. It is important that you answer their call or have your voice mail set up. They will only call **once**. If you have not heard from DDS 7 business days after Judge Fowler grants your ACLP, contact David Wood at 912-652-7280. DO NOT contact DDS!

After you receive this letter indicating Judge Fowler has signed your ACLP Order do the following: (You can use this as a check list)

- Receive call from DDS saying they are ready for you to get your ACLP.
- After call from DDS, go to Clerk's Office on 5th floor of the courthouse to get a certified copy of your ACLP Order. (You must keep this certified copy of the order on your person while you are operating your vehicle.)
- Get Ignition Interlock installed on your vehicle. (DDS will not give you a permit without proof it has been installed.)
- Take Certified Copy of ACLP and proof of ignition interlock device to DDS to receive ACLP.
- Provide the Chatham County DUI Court Coordinator (David Wood) a copy of the license.

DO NOT drive prior to receiving your ACLP from DDS.

ALL Ignition Interlock violations must be reported to David Wood no later than the next business day.

If you commit any traffic offense, even as simple as failing to stop at a stop sign, while driving on a limited permit, DDS may revoke the permit. You will not have any driving privileges during that time, even if you reach eligibility for reinstatement.

DO NOT drive in violation of your permit limitations. This too can result in a revocation of your permit.

Please remember, you are being granted this privilege due to your participation in the DUI Court program. Your driving can reflect on this program, just as your behavior does. Please, drive safely.
