## STANDING ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that any probationer who is accepted into the Drug Court Program of the Eastern Judicial Circuit is hereby removed from the physical supervision of the State Probation Office, and is not required to satisfy the general and special conditions of probation imposed under the original sentence during participation in the program. However, said probationer is required to comply with any conditions imposed as requirements of the Drug Court Program.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the State Department of Corrections, Savannah Probation Office is relieved from any supervisory responsibility of any probationer accepted into the Drug Court Program and is not required to enforce the general and special conditions of probation imposed under the original sentence during participation in the program. However, should the State Probation Office become aware of any violation of the conditions of the Drug Court Program, or any behavior that is contrary to rehabilitation, the Probation Office will notify the Drug Court Program immediately.
