STANDING ORDER

Dep. Cierk, Superior Court CHATHAM COUNTY, GA.

It has come to the attention of the Court that juveniles who are within the jurisdiction of the Superior Court are frequently placed at the Savannah Regional Youth Development Center while awaiting trial. Occasionally, a juvenile receives a non-life threatening injury or illness that requires his transportation to a hospital for treatment.

In order to expedite such treatment without delay, it is deemed necessary for this Court to execute a Standing Order authorizing the Sheriff of Chatham County to transport such juveniles upon certain conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that upon the request of the Director of the Savannah Regional Youth Development Center, or his designee, the Sheriff of Chatham County, or his lawful deputy, is hereby authorized to transport such juvenile to a hospital for treatment and to return him to the Youth Development Center after treatment. The Sheriff or deputy shall keep the juvenile under his surveillance during such periods of time.

This Order shall remain in effect until vacated or modified by this Court or a Judge of the Superior Court of the Eastern Judicial Circuit.
