STANDING ORDER No. _____

This Order amends the Standing Order entered on July 20, 2000, modifying the criminal case assignment system, to clarify the Order as follows:

All death penalty cases shall be separately assigned on a rotating basis among the active judges of this circuit. The Case Management Division of this Court is directed to maintain an alphabetical list of the judges of this circuit. Assignments of death penalty cases shall rotate in alphabetical order, beginning with the first judge on such list following the judge who has been most recently assigned a death penalty case. The purpose of this assignment system is to evenly balance the assignment of death penalty cases among the judges of this circuit.
