STANDING ORDER

OCGA 44-7-54 & 44-7-56 requires appellant-tenants in dispossessory actions to deposit prorated rents and rents due into the Registry of Court as a requirement to perfect their appeals and to remain in the premises pending the appeal. Effective this date, the Clerk of Superior Court shall henceforth accept funds to be deposited in to the Registry of the Court in conjunction with properly filed appeals in dispossessory cases.
