ORDER ESTABLISHING JUDICIAL OVERSIGHT
OF PROBATIONERS ORDERED TO COMPLETE DAY REPORTING CENTER

The Court recognizes the establishment of a Day Reporting Center [DRC] by the Department of Community Supervision in the Eastern Judicial Circuit. The need has arisen for the Court to engage in oversight of the program participants, at the request of the Department of Community Supervision.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, as follows:

A judge of the Eastern Judicial Circuit shall preside over all cases in which a probationer is ordered to complete the DRC requirements in an initial sentence, by an order revoking or modifying a sentence or by motion to amend a sentence. Upon a defendant being sentenced to participate in and complete the DRC program, the presiding judge shall take over responsibility for the case so long as the defendant is subject to the DRC requirements.

Attached hereto is the protocol for case management of all DRC cases, which is incorporated herein.
