## Pre Trial Diversion Program Rules, Regulations and Procedures

*The Pre Trial Diversion program is only for first time offenders, with non-violent crimes and non-traffic violation.* Program must be completed within <u>60 days</u>. For an extension/continuance please contact the District Attorney's office or submit via e-mail on the website

Payments are accepted at the District Attorney's office <u>Monday through Friday from 9am-3pm by</u> MONEY ORDER OR CASHIER'S CHECK. NO CASH, DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD ACCEPTED. (DO NOT CONTACT THE CLERK'S OFFICE). MONEY ORDERS/CASHIER'S CHECKS SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO: **CHATHAM COUNTY CLERK OF COURT.** 

Documents are accepted at the District Attorney's Office UPON COMPLETION before or on the scheduled court date or mailed prior to the court date. If payments/documents are made the day of court this will result in a delay in the processing of your case. Pre-Trial Diversion program fee monies are non-

refundable. NO PARTIAL PAYMENTS ACCEPTED.

- 1. Any new violations may result in a withdrawal from the Pre Trial Diversion Program. This includes traffic tickets. Any new violation must be reported to the District Attorney's Office within 72 hours of the violation.
- 2. **Drug Testing**-Every person in the Pre Trial Diversion Program for a drug charge must submit to a drug screen. The drug screen is at your own expense at a certified lab, hospital, doctor's office, or clinic. Pride Probation does drug screens for \$15, however it's your choice where you go to have the test completed. A certificate must be provided to the District Attorney's Office. The certificate must be from your own test.
- 3. Anger Management Course must be certified and cannot be completed online. The following is a list of places which offer certified courses: Recovery Place, 912-662-8700 or 912-692-0425; Union Mission, Health Services; or Success for Families and Children Enterprise, 912-323-9784 or 800-628-9202. (This is not an exclusive list).
- 4. **Substance Abuse Treatment** must be a certified course and cannot be completed online. The following is a list of certified courses. Recovery Place, Union Mission, and Health Services. (**This is not an exclusive list**).
- 5. **Defensive Driving Course** must be an approved state course.
- 6. Boating Safety Course contact the Department of Natural Resources at 912-264-7218.
- Domestic Violence Course must be certified and cannot be completed online. Certified courses can be completed at Recovery Place, 912-662-8700 or 912-692-0425; Seaport Christian Counseling 912-239-5711; or Success for Families and Children Enterprise, 912-323-9784 or 800-628-9202.
- 8. Gun Safety Course contact the Department of Natural Resources at 912-264-7218.
- 9. **Parenting Classes** cannot be competed online. Contact Department of Family and Child Services for classes at 912-651-2211; or Success for Families and Children Enterprise, 912-323-9784 or 800-628-9202. There may be free classes offered through churches in the community.
- 10. **Shoplifting Courses** can be completed online; however the course must be at least 4 hours long. The Shoplifting Alternative Course is available online <u>www.SACourseOnline.org</u>; enter Court Number 3533 or www.thefttalk.com is acceptable as well.
- 11. Victim Impact Panel cannot be an online course. Contact MADD of Georgia at 888-833-6033 for course information.
- 12. **Community Service Hours** may be completed at any non-profit organization. **No private for profit organizations may be done for work or school credit.** You must have a signed letter from the organization with a contact person for the organization, a telephone number, and the number of hours completed. *Fraudulent forms will result in prosecution for a felony.* Updated 1/23/19.
