Please note, that collecting support from a non-custodial parent in another state may be delayed or disrupted based on the limited resources, both human and financial, of the child support office located in the state that the non-custodial parent resides.

Federal and state budget cuts have lead to staff reductions in many child support offices. This in turn affects our ability to collect support from non-custodial parents located in other states. We are dependant upon the staff in other state offices to process orders and move cases forward.
