

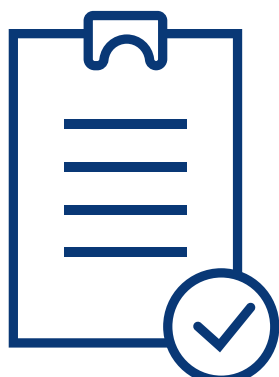


VOTING FAQ

Due to COVID-19 concerns, the Secretary of State has moved the General Primary and Non-Partisan General Election again, from May 19, 2020 to **June 9, 2020**.

Important Dates:

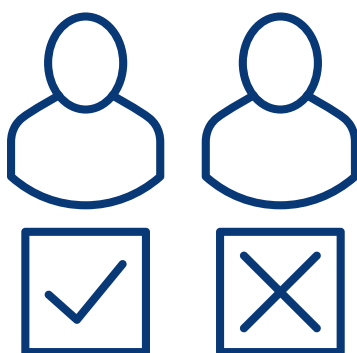
- April 21 - first day absentee ballots mailed to voters
- May 11 - last day to register to vote
- May 18 - early in-person voting begins
- June 5 - last day to request absentee ballot

WHAT'S ON THE BALLOT?

This election is the General Primary and Non-Partisan General Election. If you did not cast a ballot in the Presidential Primary, it may also be included on your June 9th ballot. You will have 3 choices -- 1) a Non-partisan only ballot (which will not include partisan races like the Presidential race), OR 2) the Republican OR 3) Democratic ballots, which will both include the non-partisan races.

BUT WHAT WILL BE ON MY BALLOT?

Due to the Primary and Non-Partisan General Elections being combined, there are 551 different ballot styles! We will post a sample ballot that will cover the basics as soon as we can, but we recommend using My Voter Page to look up your district and visiting our website to find the exact candidates you'll see!

WITH COVID-19, WILL IN-PERSON VOTING BE SAFE?

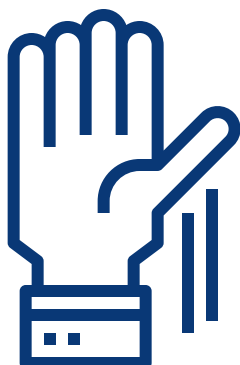
The State will be providing some sanitation solutions to help combat COVID-19 and the county will be supplementing that. You can help by voting absentee (no reason required) instead or social distancing and wearing a mask to your poll on Election Day!

HOW DO I FILL OUT MY ABSENTEE APPLICATION?

The State mailed out absentee ballot applications to every active voter in GA. When you receive yours, the most important things to remember are to CHOOSE your party ballot style, SIGN it, and DATE it! If your application is still dated for the May 19 election, don't worry -- it is still valid!

WHAT IF I DIDN'T GET MY ABSENTEE APPLICATION?

It may still be on its way, but you can call Voter Registration at 912-790-1520 to make sure that you are a registered and active voter. Keep track of your status at My Voter Page (mvp.sos.ga.gov/MVP/mvp.do)!

Ballots will be sent out starting April 21, 2020 to comply with the absentee mailing period for the new election date. Be sure to fill it out and send it back as soon as you can to make sure it gets to Voter Registration by 7pm on June 9th!
