The purpose of this quote is to obtain formal quotations for pressure washing and painting the exterior of the Henderson Golf Course Clubhouse located at 1 Al Henderson Dr. Savannah, GA. The work performed by the contractor shall include, but not be limited to, all labor, tools and material to pressure wash exterior surfaces and apply primer and two coats of white paint as described below:

Scope of Work:

Contractor is to schedule work so that paint is applied when weather conditions are in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. Siding must be dry from dew and frost prior to applying paint, and work must cease in time to allow paint to dry prior to dew and frost forming. The contractor assumes all responsibility and accountability for painting under adverse conditions.

- 1. Prior to starting work, the contractor shall check color and product to assure conformity to specified color and finish as described by project manager.
- 2. Materials shall be applied without runs, sags or cracking.
- 3. The contractor is responsible for material damaged by paint and should cover material such as brick, concrete, roofing, trees, grass and shrubs to avoid any potential damage.
- 4. Any excessive damages is to be brought to the attention of the project manager prior to priming the clubhouse.
- 5. Patches and point ups that are applied after the prime coat must be primed prior to applying the finish coat. All external areas must have two coats of white paint.
- 6. No paint on hinges, window tracks and locks, or subfloors that receive vinyl flooring.
- 7. Paint top of door frame and window casing.
- 8. Remove all dirt and mud from exterior siding prior to painting.
- 9. Brush one coat of acrylic bonding primer #515 at 3.2 mils wet film thickness. (Includes bottom edges of siding, boxing, wood windows, etc.) No less than 1 mils dry film thickness. Primer must be applied with paint brush. It may not be sprayed.
- 10. Finish coat must be 4 mils wet thickness and can be applied by spraying or brushing. No less than 1.5 mils dry film thickness.
- 11. Prime and paint wooden fence around air conditioning unit white in color.
- 12. Paint top and bottom edge of all doors and windows.
- 13. Paint bottom edge of all siding, corner stiles, shutters, bay windows, and chimney and sky lights.
- 14. Caulk all joints in exterior trim, including areas where wood joins siding. Joints and gaps exceeding 3/16" should be brought to the attention of the project manager.
- 15. Paint all roof vents and flashing black. Mechanical vents in siding to match the siding color.
- 16. Caulk with clear silicon (after finish paint is completed) at all thresholds and at the fireplace, or where trim comes in contact with a brick veneer. All silicon is to be provided by the painting contractor.
- 17. The clubhouse can be viewed during business hours 8am 5pm Monday thru Sunday.

Request for Quotation Instructions

- 1. All shipments are to be F.O.B. destination. Freight charges must be included in quotation. Delivery shall be made to the address listed on the Purchase Order and within the time specified in the quote.
- 2. Quotations subject to terms set forth herein, are requested on the following list of materials, supplies or services. On quotes for services, Chatham County insurance requirements must be met. The successful vendor must provide the County with a Certificate of Insurance listing the County as Certificate Holder.
- 3. Quote must be submitted on this sheet in spaces indicated.
- 4. Quotes for materials, supplies, vehicles, and/or equipment must be accompanied by Brochures, or copies of detailed factory specifications, ratings, technical data, including accurate descriptions of the exact materials, supplies, vehicles and/or equipment for which bids are made.
- 5. All information required by request for quotation must be completed to constitute a proper bid
- 6. Vendor warrants that the goods are merchantable and as described herein or in the solicitation response. Additional warranties may be called for in the specifications.
- 7. Chatham County is exempt, by law, from any and all federal and state taxes. Do not include taxes in your quotations. Tax exemption number is **58-60001113.** Exemption certificate will be provided upon request.
- 8. Price Protection Period of ninety (90) days for all items desired from date of bid opening. Vendors are advised that prices in effect at time of bid shall apply and not be subject to revision at time of shipment.
- 9. The County reserves the right to split this award by line item if deemed to be in its best interest
- 10. Minority/Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) Policy: It is the policy of the County to provide minority and women owned business enterprises with equal opportunity for participating in selling goods and services to the County.
- 11. **Local Preference:** Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the County's Local Preference ordinance.
- 12. **Employment Eligibility Verification:** As required under Senate Bill 529 "Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act" of 2006, O.C.G.A. Section 2, Article 3 13-10-91, public employers, their contractors and subcontractors are required to verify the work eligibility of all newly hired employees through an electronic federal work authorization program. The Georgia Department of Labor has added a new Chapter 300-10-1, entitled "Public Employers, Their Contractors and Subcontractors Required to Verify New Employee Work Eligibility Through a Federal Work Authorization Program," to the <u>Rules and Regulations of the State of Georgia</u>. The new rules designate the "Employment Eligibility Verification (EEV) Basic Pilot Program" operated by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services Bureau of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security as the electronic federal work authorization program to be utilized for these purposes. Bidders shall comply with this new rule and submit with your bid the attached "Contractor Affidavit and Agreement."

- 13. O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1, requires Georgia's cities to comply with the federal **Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program**. SAVE is a federal program used to verify that applicants for certain "public benefits" are legally present in the United States. Contracts with the County are considered "public benefits." Therefore, the bidders are required to provide the Affidavit Verifying Status for Chatham County Benefit Application prior to receiving any County contract. The affidavit is included as part of this bid package.
- 14. The original invoice is to be submitted to the County Finance Department. The purchase order number must be shown on all invoices and packing lists.
- 15. References may be requested of the successful bidder.
