Addendum #1

- 1. Sheet A1.2, Coordination Notes: as noted, the owner shall be responsible to install/relocate furnishings and equipment.
- 2. Sheet A1.5: the wood roof trusses can be used to support the materials permitted by IBC 717.4 (such as 1/2" gyp bd, 3/8" plywood, etc) to compartmentalize the attic.
- 3. Sheet A1.5: location of gutters is limited to inside corners of north addition, as shown on the roof plan.
- 4. Sheets A2.1 & A2.2: the exterior face of the split face CMU at all sides of the north addition are not to be painted, as indicated.
- 5. Sheets A2.1, A2.2 & A2.3: the elevations are shown correctly to scale (3/16" = 1"). But the graphic scale is not correct (disregard the graphic scale).
- 6. Sheet A1.5: the dimensions and quantities shown in detail 1 are relative to the horizontal attic area and are not roofing quantities.
- 7. Sheet S1.2: the details correctly indicate #89 stone in lieu of sand (stone provides better drainage).
- 8. Base Bid to include a new data closet:
 - a. Closet to be located in existing storage room shown on sheet A1.4.
 - b. Walls of closet to be CMU as noted on A1.4.
 - c. Interior dimensions of closet to be 4' wide by 5' deep (two of the walls that define this closet will be existing walls).
 - d. Cut existing CMU wall and provide a new door (match door 2 on sheet A7.1, except storage lockset). Door to swing out, into exercise area.
 - e. Cut and patch existing CMU wall per structural drawings.
 - f. Bid to include rerouting of a presumed electrical line that likely exists in the existing wall to be cut for new door (a series of wall outlets exist on this wall).
 - g. Provide (2) wall mounted duplex receptacles, with power, each receptacle on a separate circuit.
 - h. Provide a light fixture, with power, match type 'D' on sheet E1.2.
 - i. Provide grill in bottom of door, aluminum with mill finish, 20" wide by 8" tall.
 - j. Provide thru wall transfer grill above door (in CMU wall), aluminum with mill finish, 20" wide by 8" tall. Locate close to ceiling (+/-10'-4" above the floor). Locate the grill in the CMU coursing such that a vertical CMU joint will be centered on the grill above and below the grill.
