Section 11050 "Flap Gates" of the Technical Specifications shall be considered to be modified as follows:

A. Part I - General, Summary of Description of Work, Summary shall be amended to include the following acceptable manufacturer:

B. Part II - General, Submittals, Shop Drawings, shall be amended with the addition of the following statements:

Final and complete shop drawings for the gate shall be submitted to Chatham County within three weeks of Notice to Proceed. The gate submitted shall include the design calculations. Each of the submitted drawings shall be reviewed by a licensed professional engineer; each drawing shall contain the engineer's signature and seal/stamp.

C. Part III - Execution, Factory Assembly and Field Testing, Paragraph 3 shall be amended as follows:

Delete first sentence and replace with:

"The gate manufacturer shall provide a qualified factory employed serviceman with a minimum of ten years field experience on similar products and applications to fully inspect the completed installations and, with the assistance of the contractor, to make adjustments to alignment, lubrication, free operation and proper control and to instruct the Owner's personnel in the proper operation and maintenance of the units. The resume of the proposed serviceman shall be submitted for the review and approval of Chatham County.
