
Jennifer Ross Parking and Drop-Off Addendum #2

- 1. Bid item No 1010 is for a safety end section the plans and details indicate a Std flared end section. What are we to price?
 - Pay item No 1010 will be changed to Flared End Section
- 2. There is no pay item for the bollards indicated on plan SH No. 4. Could you add a pay item for this?
 - A pay item for the bollards will be added to the bid sheet.
- 3. There is no pay item for the headwall shown on Plan SH No 4 for the storm line outfall at the drainage canal. Could you add a pay item for this?
 - This headwall is existing and will be retained. No pay item shall be added for a headwall.
- 4. There is no pay item for the grate inlet in the middle of the storm line leading to the drainage canal. Could you add a pay item for this?
 - The grate inlet on the plans is existing.
- 5. Bid item No 1002 is GABC by the SY but does not indicate the required thickness. Could the thickness of the base be added to the pay item?
 - The thickness of the base will not be added as a pay item. Please refer to the typical sections.
- 6. Bid item No 1014 concrete sidewalk 4'. It appears that the quantity for this pay item is incorrect. Can the quantity be checked?
 - Pay item No 1014 should be 86-LF. The bid sheet will be revised to reflect the correct quantity.
- 7. Plan SH No 9 show two temporary sediment basins (SD3). Could a pay item be added for this?
 - No, a pay item will not be added. The temporary sediment basins are same as the retention ponds, which are included in grading complete.
- 8. Bid item No 1029 Erosion Control Mats Slopes. There are no Erosion Control Mats indicated on the Erosion Control drawings.
 - Erosion control mats (Mb) will be added to the Erosion Sediment & Pollution Control Plan and the quantity on the bid sheet will be revised.
- 9. The storm drain line leading to the drainage canal indicates both 15" & 18" for the same run of pipe. Can this be clarified as to which size is intended?
 - The correct diameter of the pipe is 18", which is existing. This run of pipe will be retained and deducted from the bid sheet.
- 10. Plan SH No 9 indicates retro-fitting the 15" RCP extending from Eisenhower Drive. There is no retrofit pay item can one be added?
 - A pay item will not be added. The existing 15" RCP and flared end section are existing. No retrofitting is required.
- 11. Could you provide a detail for the bollards shown on plan SH no 4? We need to know the bury depth, the height above grad, are they to be set in concrete and are they to be treated or painted?
 - A standard detail of the bollards will be added. They shall be pressure treated and set in concrete.

- 12. There is specifications for both paint and thermo in Spec Section 02600-13 paragraph 2.13. Are the pavement markings to be thermo or paint and if it is paint will it be the old GDOT Spec or the new one?
 - Use paint for the pavement markings. This item shall conform to the City of Savannah standards and the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- 13. On plan SH No 3 Layout & Striping there are no Handi Cap signs indicated. Will we be required to install HC signs and if so will they be required to be installed in bollards?
 - Please see the revised Layout and Striping plan for handicap sign location.
- 14. Can you provide the CADD files for the project?
 - A CADD file will not be provided until the contract is awarded.

- LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT FOR THE CITY OF SAVANNAH OR DESIGNEE. ANY DEVIATION FROM THESE PLANS IN EITHER SPECIES OR LAYOUT MUST BE SPECIFICALLY APPROVED BY TH PLANTS SHALL BE TRUE TO SPECIES AND VARIETY SPECIFIED, AND NURSERY-GROWN IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOOD
- PLANTS SHALL CONFORM TO THE MEASUREMENTS SPECIFIED ON THE APPROVED PLAN(S)
- CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INSPECTION OF EXISTING CONDITIONS AND MUST PROMPTLY REPORT ANY
- NO LARGE OR MEDIUM TREE SPECIES SHALL BE PLANTED WITHIN 10-FEET OF ANY UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINE ORUNDERNEATH ANY OVERHEAD POWER LINES, AND SMALL TREE SPECIES MUST MAINTAIN A MINIMUM 5-FOOT SEPARATION FROM UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES.
- INJURY, GIRDLING ROOTS, OR OTHER OBJECTIONABLE FEATURES THAT WOULD CAUSE THE TREE TO DECLINE OR BECOME STRUCTURALLY UNSOUND. TREES SHALL BE WELL-BRANCHED AND DENSELY FOLIATED WHEN IN LEAF. ALL TREES SHALL BE HEALTHY, VIGOROUS, WITH A NORMAL HABIT OF GROWTH, EVEN DISTRIBUTION OF BRANCHES, A STRAIGHT TRUNK WHICH EXHIBITS GOOD TRUNK TAPER, WITH LIMBS NOT LOWER THAN FOUR FEET ABOVE THE GROUND DEPENDENT UPON THE SPECIES, AND SHALL BE FREE FROM DISEASE, INSECT INFESTATION, MECHANICAL
- THE CITY OF SAVANNAH PARK AND TREE DEPARTMENT. SUCH APPROVAL SHALL NOT IMPAIR THE RIGHT OF INSPECTION AND REJECTION DURING PROGRESS OF THE WORK. ACCEPTANCE AT THE NURSERY, IN WHICH THE PLANT IS GROWING, PRIOR TO TRANSPLANTING, DOES NOT PRECLUDE REJECTION AT THE SITE FOR JUST CAUSE. PLANTS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION FOR CONFORMITY TO SPECIFICATIONS REQUIREMENTS AND APPROVAL BY
- TREE SHALL BE PLANTED AT PROPER DEPTH OR SHALL BE REJECTED AT TIME OF INSPECTION
- STAKE TREES ONLY WHEN NECESSARY. STAKING AND GUYING SHALL FOLLOW THE CITY OF SAVANNAH'S PARK AND TREE DEPARTMENT SPECIFICATIONS WHEN USED.
- 11. LANDSCAPE CONTRACTORS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND A PRE-PLANTING MEETING WITH THE CITY OF SAVANNAH'S PARK AND TREE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO THE START OF THE PROJECT. PLEASE CONTACT THE PARK AND TREE DEPARTMENT SITE INSPECTOR AT (912) 651-6610 TO SET UP THE MEETING.


- TREE PROTECTION SHALL ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS AS SPECIFIED IN:
- B. THE LANDSCAPE AND TREE ORDINANCE COMPLIANCE MANUAL OF THE CITY OF SAVANNA H
- THE TREE PROTECTION DEVICE (UNLESS DIRECTED OTHERWISE BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT FOR THE CITY OF SPACED NO FARTHER THAN 8' APART. SAVANNAH OR DESIGNEE) SHALL BE A 4' TEMPORARY CHAIN LINK FENCE CONSTRUCTED AT AND AROUND THE PERIMETER OF THE TREE PROTECTION ZONE. THE FENCE SHALL BE ATTACHED TO GALVANIZED METAL POSTS,
- TREE PROTECTION DEVICES SHALL BE ERECTED PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION AND SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL ALL SITE AND EXTERIOR BUILDING WORK IS COMPLETED AND LANDSCAPE INSTALLATION HAS BEGUN. BROKEN OR DISLODGED TREE PROTECTION DEVICES SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY REPAIRED.
- ALL DESIGNATED TREE PROTECTION ZONES MUST BE PROTECTED FROM THE SEDIMENTATION OF EROSION MATERIAL.
- SILT FENCING SHALL BE PLACED ALONG THE OUTER UPHILL EDGE OF TREE PROTECTION ZONES AT THE LAND
- SILT FENCING SHALL BE BACKED BY 4' CHAIN LINK FENCE IN AREAS OF STEEP SLOPES
- NO VEHICLES SHALL BE PARKED, OR CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL STORED OR SUBSTANCES POURED OR DISPOSED OF OR PLACED, WITHIN ANY TREE PROTECTION ZONE AT ANY TIME DURING CLEARING OR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT.
- NO CHANGE IN GRADE WITHIN THE TREE PROTECTION ZONE SHALL BE ALLOWED AROUND EXISTING TREES EXCEPT FOR A MAXIMUM ADDITIONAL OF TWO INCHES OF MULCH UNLESS APPROVED BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT FOR
- CONSENT FROM THE CITY OF SAVANNAH'S PARK AND TREE DEPARTMENT TREES WITHIN A TREE PROTECTION ZONE SHALL NOT BE PRUNED OR REMOVED WITHOUT PRIOR KNOWLEDGE AND
- ALL RETAINED OR PLANTED TREES SHALL BE PROTECTED OR SITUATED SO AS TO PREVENT DAMAGE FROM ENVIRONMENTAL CHANGES OR LAND DISTURBANCE RESULTING FROM ANY BUILDING OR FACILITY CONSTRUCTION WITHIN OR IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO THE CRITICAL ROOT ZONE OF THE TREE(S).


