QUESTIONS RECEIVED:

1.Q) Do you plan to use a unitary playground surface or will this be loose-fill?

A) Please refer to L1.1 and L2.8 in plans for playground layout and surface detail respectively. Refer to section 02791-1 through 02791-3 for playground surface system and section 02881-1 through 02881-11 for playground equipment and structures in the Tom Triplett Specifications. It appears that engineered wood is specified for the playground surface.

2.Q) Does the playground 2-D design image reflect the actual equipment specs listed in the bid documents for tom Triplett Park?

A) The drawing in the plan reflects the equipment listed in the Tom Triplett Specifications. Please refer to pipeline model number 9817 for a 3D image of something very similar with a couple things changed by the plans in the following link :
