FOR: Design and Engineering Services for Replacement of 16" Force Main on Sallie Mood Drive/Agonic Road

## PLEASE SEE THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONS, CLARIFICATIONS AND/OR CHANGES:

- 1. **Question:** Casey Canal crossing will either be as it currently is or a bore under the canal engineer to decide?
  - **Response:** Due to Casey Canal being in City of Savannah right-of-way, the Consultant will work with City Engineers to determine the best course to take in regards to boring under the canal or to connect as it stands now.
- 2. **Question:** Subsurface Utility (S.U.E.) will be needed? How much or how many cross sections?
  - **Response:** Yes, S.U.E. Level A every 200' to 400' based on the nearest conflicts (i.e., driveways, intersections, existing utilities, ctc.).
- 3. **Question:** How will the utilities be located? By Radar, by potholing, and/or by design locate?
  - Response: Consultant will use the potholing method.
- 4, **Question:** Replace or slip line the existing FM?
  - **Response:** Consultant should recommend method by evaluating the capital and maintenance cost of the replaced force main.
- 5. Question: Proposed FM material (if replaced) engineer will decide?: Response: Consultant should recommend material of force main.
- 6. **Question**: Permitting with City's SPR?
  - **Response**: Consultant will be responsible for all City permitting.
- 7. Question: Permitting with NRCS for the erosion and pollution control plans?

  Response: NRCS permit may be needed for Phase 1 but it will not be necessary for Phase 2.
- 8. Question: How much Geotechnical will be needed (Section 5.2.2.b)?
- Response: Geotechnical bores every 500' should be adequate.
- 9. Question: Will an environmental site assessment be needed (Section 5.2.3.c)? Response: No, an environmental site assessment will not be required.
