Questions Received:

- 1. Q) Bridge notes on S7 call for SELECT STRUCTURAL GRADE lumber and the STRINGER TABLE calls for No. 2 Dense. Which grade should be used for stringers? Also, most cap, stringers, decking, and rail material used in this type of bridges is SYP Grade No. 1 or better; will this grade be acceptable?

 A) Dense Grade No. 1 Southern Pine is acceptable (minimum allowable bending stress $F_b = or > 1035$ psi for stringers and caps).
- 2. Q) The glulam stringers are treated with Penta; however, since people will be using the bridges, will you accept ACQ, CA ground treatment or equivalent for decking and rails.
- A) Use 2.5 lb/ft³ CCA, chromated copper arsenate Type 1.
- 3. Q) Can the piling, cap timbers, and stringers at bridge 12 be 2.5 CCA in lieu of Penta?
- A) Use 2.5 lb/ft³ CCA, chromated copper arsenate Type 1.
- 4. Q) We are having difficulty locating a #10x9" galvanized timber screw required for the blocking attached to the stringers. Can lag bolts, 9" min length be substituted?
- A) 9" galvanized lag bolts are acceptable.
- 5. Q) Are the Timbers to be rough Sawn or Square four sides dressed?
- A) Timber sizes are dressed, four sides.
- 6. Q) On Sheet S1 the bulkhead sections say *DOUBLE 6X12 TIMBER WALES*; the existing bulkhead has 2x6 wales and on this drawing they are drawn as 2x6s. Could you verify that the wales should be double 2x6?
- A) Double 6X12 wales required, as noted.
