QUESTION RECEIVED:

- 1. Q) Will there be any consideration for alternate cooling tower manufacturers? If so, will there be an allowance to exceptions to the specifications?
- A) There will be no alternates considered regarding the cooling towers.
- 2. Q) It was noted at the Pre-Bid that conditioning of the facility is required to be maintained while the cooling towers are being replaced. Please provide the capacity needed to maintain cooling conditions of the facility.
- A) Requires 1 of the 386 ton units to remain on.
- 3.Q) Does one of the existing chiller/cooling tower arrangements has sufficient capacity for conditioning the facility, if so, define which one and can it be used for conditioning during the cooling tower replacement, or will a temporary chiller be required.
- A) Attached to this addendum is a layout showing the cooling towers and chillers again 1 of the 386t must remain active. As you can see by the drawing chiller 3 can stay active while the twin cooling tower and the small cooling tower is removed.
