	Response:	No, on average, weekend tests occur roughly once per month.
5.	<u>Question:</u>	Are we required to test on holidays?
	Response:	Yes
6.	Question:	What is the total budget for the RFP NO. 21-0038-7?
	<u>Response:</u>	Funding for the program comes from, inter alia, local funds and grant funds, which are allocated on a yearly basis. Service providers are advised to submit their most competitive fee proposal.

	Response:	Yes, companies are allowed to partner or have a subconsultant as part of their team.
