Local Preference: On 27 March, 1998, the Chatham County Board of Commissioners adopted a "Local Vendor" Preference Ordinance that gives the lowest Chatham County vendor submitting a responsible bid/quote the opportunity to match the lowest price offered by an out-of-County vendor. If the County vendor confirms in writing to match within 24 hours, the award will be made to the Chatham County vendor. The lowest Chatham County responsive bidder will be afforded the "right to first refusal". "Local Vendor" is defined as a business or supplier which operates and maintains a regular place of business within the geographical boundaries of Chatham County, or one of the local Municipalities of the County AND all real and personal property taxes are paid prior to award of a contract or purchase. NOTE: Local Preference does not apply to Public Works/Construction contracts.

Chatham County has established goals to increase participation of minority and female owned businesses. In order to accurately document participation, businesses submitting bids or proposals are strongly encouraged to report ownership status. GENERAL TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND EXCEPTIONS

- 1.11 Guarantee: Unless otherwise specified by the County, the bidder shall unconditionally guarantee the materials and workmanship on all material and/or services. If, within the guarantee period any defects occur which are due to faulty material and or services, the contractor at his expense, shall repair or adjust the condition, or replace the material and/or services to the complete satisfaction of the County. These repairs, replacement or adjustments shall be made only at such time as will be designed by the County as being least detrimental to the operation of County business.
- 1.12 Qualification of Business (Responsible Bidder or Proposer): A responsible bidder or proposer is defined as one who meets, or by the date of the bid acceptance can meet, all requirements for licensing, insurance, and service contained within this Invitation for Bids or Proposals. Chatham County has the right to require any or all bidders to submit documentation of the ability to perform, provide, or carry out the service or provide the product requested.
- 1.13 County Tax Certificate Requirement: Contractor must supply a copy of their Tax Certificate as proof of payment of the occupational tax where their office is located. Please contact the Chatham County Department of Building and Regulatory Services at (912) 201-4300 for additional information.
- 1.14 Delinquent Real and Personal Property Taxes: No contract shall be awarded unless all real and personal property taxes have been paid by the successful contractor and/or subcontractors as adopted by the Board of Commissioners on April 8, 1994.
- 1.15 Insurance Provisions: The selected CONTRACTOR shall be required to procure and maintain for the duration of the contract insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the performance of the work hereunder by the Contractor, his agents, representatives, employees or subcontractors. The cost of such insurance shall be included in the Bid. Contract work will not proceed unless Chatham County has in their possession, a current Certificate of Insurance.

- 1.15.1 General Information that shall appear on a Certificate of Insurance:
 - I. Name of the Producer (Contractor's insurance Broker/Agent).
 - II. Companies affording coverage (there may be several).
 - III. Name and Address of the Insured (this should be the Company or Parent of the firm Chatham County is contracting with).
 - IV. A Summary of all current insurance for the insured (includes effective dates of coverage).
 - V. A brief description of the operations to be performed, the specific job to be performed, or contract number.
 - VI. Certificate Holder (This is to always include Chatham County).

1.15.2 Minimum Limits of Insurance to be maintained for the duration of the contract;

- A. Commercial General Liability: Provides protection against bodily injury and property damage claims arising from operations of a Contractor or Tenant. This policy coverage includes: premises and operations, use of independent contractors, products/completed operations, personal injury, contractual, broad form property damage, and underground, explosion and collapse hazards. Minimum limits: \$1,000,000 bodily injury and property damage per occurrence and annual aggregate.
- B. Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability: Provides statutory protection against bodily injury, sickness or disease sustained by employees of the Contractor while performing within the scope of their duties. Employer's Liability coverage is usually included in Worker's Compensation policies, and insures common law claims of injured employees made in lieu of or in addition to a Worker's Compensation claim. Minimum limits: \$500,000 for each accident., disease policy limit, disease each employee and Statutory Worker's Compensation limit.
- C. **Business Automobile Liability:** Coverage insures against liability claims arising out of the Contractor's use of automobiles. Minimum limit: \$1,000,000 combined single limit per accident for bodily injury and property damage. Coverage should be written on an "Any Auto" basis.

1.15.3 Special Requirements:

A. Claims-Made Coverage: The limits of liability shall remain the same as the occurrence basis, however, the Retroactive date shall be prior to the coincident with the date of any contract, and the Certificate of Insurance shall state the coverage is claims-made. The Retroactive date shall also be specifically stated on the Certificate of Insurance.

- B. **Extended Reporting Periods**: The Contractor shall provide the County with a notice of the election to initiate any Supplemental Extended Reporting Period and the reason(s) for invoking this option.
- C. **Reporting Provisions:** Any failure to comply with reporting provisions of the policies shall not affect coverage provided in relation to this request.
- D. **Cancellation:** Each insurance policy that applies to this request shall be endorsed to state that it shall not be suspended, voided, or canceled, except after thirty (30) days prior to written notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, has been given to the County.
- E. **Proof of Insurance:** Chatham County shall be furnished with certificates of insurance and with original endorsements affecting coverage required by this request. The certificates and endorsements are to be signed by a person authorized by the insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. All certificates of insurance are to be submitted prior to, and approved by, the County before services are rendered. The Contractor must ensure Certificate of Insurance is updated for the entire term of the County.
- F. **Insurer Acceptability:** Insurance is to be placed with an insurer having an A.M. Best's rating of A and a five (5) year average financial rating of not less than V. If an insurer does not qualify for averaging on a five year basis, the current total Best's rating will be used to evaluate insurer acceptability.
- G. Lapse in Coverage: A lapse in coverage shall constitute grounds for contract termination by the Chatham County Board of Commissioners.
- H. **Deductibles and Self-Insured Retention**: Any deductibles or self-insured retention must be declared to, and approved by, the County. At the option of the County, either: the insurer shall reduce or eliminate such deductibles or self-insured retention as related to the County, its officials, officers, employees, and volunteers; or the Contractor shall procure a bond guaranteeing payment of related suits, losses, claims, and related investigation, claim administration and defense expenses.
- **1.16 References:** Provide with the quote, three (3) references. Also include company name, address, phone number, contact person.
- 1.17 DEBARRED FIRMS AND PENDING LITIGATION: Any potential proposer/firm listed on the Federal or State of Georgia Excluded Parties Listing (Barred from doing business) will not be considered for contract award. Proposers

shall disclose any record of pending lawsuits, criminal violations and/or convictions, etc., and **shall** not have conflicts of interest. Any proposer/firm previously defaulting or terminated a contract with the County will not be considered. A statement of Disclosure **must** be provided with response.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The purpose of this quotation is to obtain formal quotations to furnish and install a shredder and baler system for Chatham County Administrative Services Department located at 4225 Augusta Rd. Scope of Work

Delivery and Installation of one (1) shredder and one (1) baler with optional conveyor belt. Acceptable manufacture is Allegheny 16 series model 16-75C 5 HP or 16-150C 7.5 HP shredder or equivalent. All machines must be powered by 208, 230, or 460 volt, 3 phase connection. Standard Baler with bale size of 60"L x 30"W x 48"H and a bale weight of 1,000 – 1,200 lbs. A free standing output conveyor belt from shredder to baler. Included with this equipment are the following:

- Provide training on use and maintenance of shredder and baler immediately after installation.
- Provide two copies of operator, service and parts manuals.
- Standard manufacturer's warranty for a period of not less than one year, including parts, material and labor.
- Provide list of "local" authorized vendors that can provide emergency service/maintenance when requested.

NOTE: A refurbished shredder and/or baler are optional in this quotation. The shredder and/or baler must be one (1) to seven (7) years old and / or have been in services for up to seven years prior to being refurbished for sale.

Quality Assurance:

1. Work will be performed from 8:00 to 5:00 Monday through Friday excluding holidays. Alternate hours may be arranged with prior approval. All installation procedures shall be performed in accordance to the manufacturers' requirements. Periodic cleaning of the work area and at the close of each work day shall be performed to minimize the spread of dust and debris. All technicians are required to be in company uniform at all times. An Identification Card issued from company must be worn and visible at all times during installation and service of the system.

Warranty:

1. The shredder and baler system and its components must be fully warranted, parts and labor, with a two (2) hour on site response, for one full year from the date of acceptance. A two (2) year warranty / service agreement for parts and labor, four (4) hour response will prices and stated as a line item separate from shredder and baler system.
