

Meeting Minutes
Special Called Meeting
Chatham County Board of Registrars
November 4, 2019

The Board convened at 12:04 p.m. for a Special Called Meeting to consider challenges to voter qualifications brought by the City of Tybee Island. Board members present were Mr. McRae, Ms. Andrews, Mr. Norse, Mr. Pannell and Mr. Slay. Staff present were Ms. German, Mrs. Bostick and Mr. Pflager. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited to begin the proceedings.

Tybee Island Voter Challenges:

Mr. McRae began by providing an overview of the Board's regular monthly meeting on October 23, 2019 and the process for bringing a challenge to a voter's qualifications. Mr. McRae also outlined the Board's previous consideration of challenges to voter qualifications brought by the City of Tybee Island at the October 23, 2019 regular monthly meeting.

Ms. Jan LeViner, Clerk of Council for the City of Tybee Island, presented challenges to voter qualifications based on active/inactive status of utility billing by the City of Tybee Island as well as property record cards from the Chatham County Assessor's office.

The Board also heard from Mr. and Mrs. Sheffield who had received notice that their qualifications were being challenged. Mr. Sheffield explained that both were still residents of Tybee Island and thus the Board voted to withdraw the challenge to their qualifications.

After considering all of the available evidence brought forward by Ms. LeViner, the Board did vote to uphold challenged status of 3 voters with a completed change of address, 1 deceased voter and 1 voter who confirmed moving out of state. The Board also voted based on a motion by Mr. Slay, seconded by Ms. Andrews, to dismiss all other challenges brought forward today with the exception of Mr. and Mrs. Fox.
