2020 is going to be an exciting and productive year with the upcoming elections beginning with the Presidential Preference Primary/Special Election on March 24, 2020.

Check or update change of name/address to your voter registration on the GA MVP page at mvp.sos.ga.gov. The voter registration deadline for the Presidential Primary/Special Election is February 24, 2020.

Absentee by Mail applications are currently being accepted until March 20, 2020. Advanced Voting begins March 2, 2020 through March 20, 2020.

2020 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY/SPECIAL ELECTION
Election Date: **MARCH 24, 2020**

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 24, 2020

Prior to Election Day: confirm your registration and poll location by calling Voter Registration at (912) 790-1520 or use the **MY VOTER PAGE** website at www.mvp.sos.ga.gov. Keep your residence and mailing address updated with the Voter Registration Office.

ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL:

FEBRUARY 4, 2020 – MARCH 20, 2020

Mail out of absentee ballots will begin on **February 4, 2020** and end on **March 20, 2020**. A request for an absentee ballot may be submitted by mail, email, fax or you may complete the application in person at our office. You must file a separate application for each election and run-off election for which you are requesting an absentee ballot; except if you are a voter who is over the age of 65, disabled, a military service member or spouse of a service member, or an overseas citizen (temporary or permanent). Call Chatham County Voter Registration at (912) 790-1520 for further details. Absentee request forms can be accepted 180 days prior to an election.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING:

MARCH 2, 2020 – MARCH 20, 2020

Early in-person voting is available 21 days prior to the election. Any eligible registered Chatham County voter desiring to vote in advance during this period may do so in-person. No reason is required.

**GEORGIA SECRETARY OF STATE
BRAD RAFFENSPERGER**

As Secretary of State, Brad Raffensperger made it his top priority to secure Georgia's election systems. Following bipartisan legislation, recommendations from a bipartisan commission, and a fair bid process, Secretary Raffensperger and his office selected the most secure and cost-effective voting system in America.

The Secretary and his team has partnered with Department of Homeland Security (DHS), The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), as well as private-sector security experts to provide a layered approach to cyber security.

In November of 2019, Georgia was the first state in the Southeast to conduct a risk-limiting audit of an election: A systematic way to validate the integrity of election results.

SECURE THE VOTE

✓ Secure Selections



Once you have inserted your voter card into the touchscreen ballot marking device, your ballot will appear and you will be able to make your selections behind a secure, privacy screen.

✓ Secure Paper Ballot

After printing your paper ballot, **review** your choices to ensure they are correct.



✓ Secure Your Vote

After confirming that the printed, paper ballot accurately reflects your choices, take both the voter card from the ballot marking device and your printed, paper ballot from the voting station. Insert your printed, paper ballot into the secure scanner and watch as your official ballot is cast.



Make sure to return your voter card to the poll workers before you leave. Wear your secure voting sticker with pride!






ABSENTEE BY MAIL TRAINING - 01/14/2020

On January 14, 2020 our office held an Absentee by Mail training class for nursing home staff and caregivers.


This opportunity provided those staff members the knowledge and understanding on the process and how to assist their residents or patients in completing an absentee by mail application as well as how to mail in ballots.
